## Research and development

- Develop a <u>draft framework</u> of evidence-informed health priority setting that supports countries in identifying appropriate steps and methods when developing and implementing national research agenda.
- Working on a series of qualitative studies to understand how to engage individuals from different ethnicities and languages in setting priorities for research.
- Conduct a <u>mixed-methods analysis</u> on James Lind Alliance on preterm birth priority setting.



## Best practice and guidance

• Working on developing and reviewing the Multi-Ethno-Linguistic Tool Kit (MELT) to support research groups in developing inclusive research priority-setting exercises.



## Methods implementation

- Consult with the Climate Health Working Group to help them inform their decisions on priority setting.
- Support the Cochrane-Campbell Global Ageing Partnership to develop <u>a priority-setting</u> <u>exercise</u>.
- Organise a <u>Training Workshop</u> on setting priorities for Cochrane groups in the 2023 Cochrane Colloquium in London.
